For the trip of a lifetime, try this traveling trip. You will travel by horse from camp to camp every other day. Everything will be provided for you; all the food, all the necessary camp equipment, a cook, and a packer so you can sit back and relax while someone else does all the work. All you will need to bring is your personal gear & sleeping bag. You will travel along mountain trails, camp near alpine lakes and streams. We recommend trips of four to six days in length.



The Prospector

The first night you'll stay in one of the new cabins or a room in our new lodge near the old Cornucopia mining camp right next door to the Eagle Cap Wilderness. You'll have the remarkable experience of an evening in a classic, high-walled mountain valley while you enjoy your family style dinner. In the morning you ride deep into the wilderness passing through time and country into the Old West where miners searched for and found gold.

All you need to bring is your personal gear, sleeping bag, and sleeping pad. But if you don't have a sleeping bag, we'll even provide one so you won't miss the experience of a lifetime sleeping under stars big enough to touch. And bring a camera. The views on the ride are worth framing. On the third day we'll ride back to Cornucopia for a hot shower, another delicious Western dinner, and your final night in a cabin.

We will combine smaller groups to make one group of 8.

The Sourdough Special

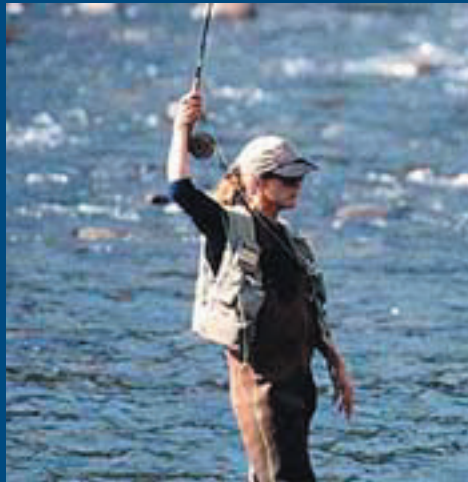
The Sourdough Special is a six-day adventure beginning the first day with a ride from Cornucopia Wilderness Pack Station to your base camp. On other days you will ride to different locations where you might fish in the lake, hike to the abandoned mines, ride along a scenic river or spend time just relaxing around the campfire. These trips are designed to show you what the Eagle Cap Wilderness has to offer. Everything is provided, including the wranglers, cooks, food and all the necessary equipment. You just bring your personal gear and sleeping bag, camera, and fishing pole.

We will combine smaller groups to make one group of 8 or you can book a single party.



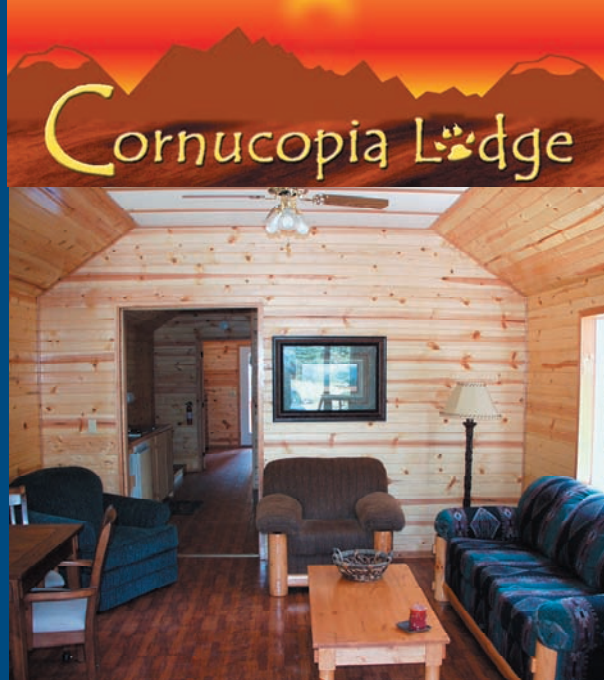
Pine Lakes Camp

Seven miles from Cornucopia, nestled in a bowl, high in the mountains, sit Pine Lakes, two alpine jewels separated by only a few yards and filled with voracious brook trout that attack almost any lure. We'll pack you, your food, and your personal gear to our camp that's already set up and waiting for you. All the necessary camp equipment, the tents, stoves, lanterns, and other essential camping equipment is provided. A three day adventure.

Each trip is designed to meet your specific needs. You provide all the necessary equipment and food. We'll provide the horses and mules to pack you in and out of your campsite. If you're Backpacking, you hike where you want and we pack your gear to your campsite. One way or both ways, your choice.

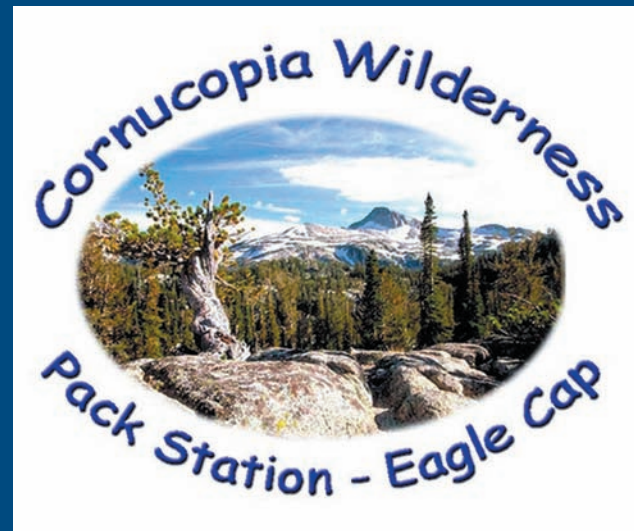
